WHEREAS: the contributions made by those concerned with Quality Control have stimulated similar motivation among other citizens in whatever vocations they may be engaged; and


WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota wishes to further promote the ideals of Quality Control as applied to all products for all consumers everywhere;





