depose and says:

Prior to Oct. 8, 1923, this deponent was duly appointed by the secretary of state of the state of Minnesota, pursuant to Chapter 417, Laws of 1921, as supervisor of census, and Geo. Matakovich, P. A. McEachin and Carl Cusciotta, all of the Village of Keewatin and state of Minnesota, were duly appointed by said secretary of state, pursuant to said act, as enumerators of the census, and this deponent and the three above mentioned enumerators were directed by the secretary of state aforesaid to take a census of the residents of the Village of Keewatin, Itasca County, Minnesota.

That thereafter, this deponent and said enumerators agreed in writing and under oath to perform their duties in connection with said census faithfully and impartially and under the direction of said secretary of state, as more fully appears from Exhibits A, B, C, D. hereto attached and made a part hereof.

That between the dates of October the Eighth and October the Thirteenth, 1923, all of the inhabitants of said Village were personally interviewed by one of the four enumerators above mentioned, working under deponents supervision; that a separate card was prepared for each of the residents of said

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
