- COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. As compensation for satisfactory performance of the duties herein described, the Special Attorney shall be compensated on a \$30.00 per hour basis. The Special Attorney shall be reimbursed for reasonable disbursements and for travel expenses in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the State of Minnesota, Department of Personnel governing the travel of state officers and employees. All compensation and expenses shall be paid from funds appropriated to the Department of Human Rights.
- STATUS. The Special Attorney shall not be considered a state employee, shall not be eligible for the state's life insurance or basic health benefits coverage and shall not accrue vacation or sick leave or any benefits other than those expressly provided herein.
