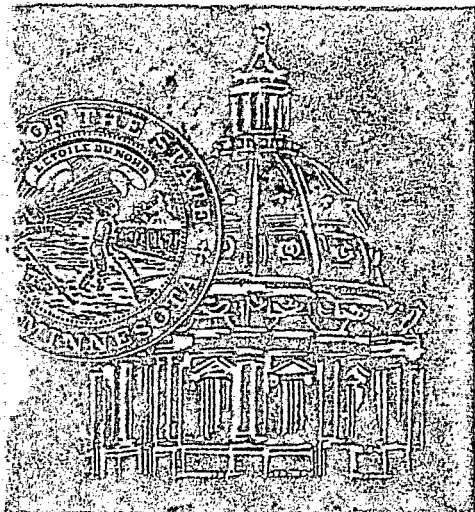


State of Minnesota
