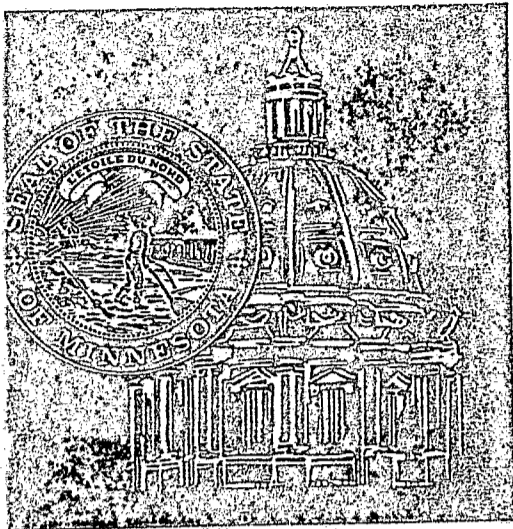

BOY SCOUT MONTH


