
HEREAS: the Mrs. Jaycees of Minnesota provide leadership training to tomorrow's leaders; and


HEREAS: their creed states: "May we leave the world a better place because we lived and served within it";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 21 through 27, 1977 as


