WHEREAS: the progress and well-being of the citizens of Minnesota depend to a great extent upon education and training for the "World of Work" as provided in the school systems of this state; and

WHEREAS: projound sociological, economic and technological changes in our society are bringing aborapid changes in the structure and nature of the "World of Work" thereby placing new and additional responsibilities on the educational system; and

WHEREAS: the Congress of the United States and the Legislature of the State of Minnesota have recognized these problems and have acted upon them through appropriate legislation; and

WHEREAS: professional contributions of the vocational educators of this State have assisted youth and adults in the process of preparation for work; and

WHEREAS: the American Vocational Association, by representative assembly, has established the secure week in February as "Vocational Education Week" and is supported by the Minnesota Vocation Association in this action;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week o February 6 through 12, 1977 as

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens of the State to observe this week by making themselves better acquainted with Vocational Education purposes and programs by visiting any vocational institution or program in their area.
