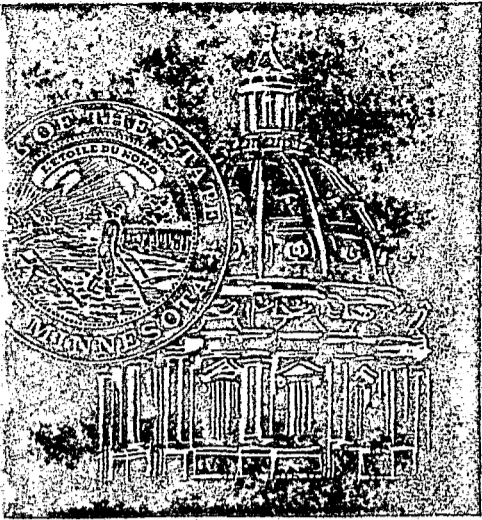

WHEREAS: VICA programs emphasize respect for the dignity of work, high standards in trade ethics, workmanship, scholarship and safety; and


WHEREAS: VICA strives to develop each student's social and leadership abilities as well as his skills;

VOCATIONAL INDUSTRIAL CLUBS OF AMERICA WEEK


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be aware of the good work done by those engaged in industrial education...work that better the student and his community, state, nation and world.
