WHEREAS: Ski for Light Inc., a nonprofit Minnesota corporation, is sponsoring a cross-country ski-a-thon at Honeywell Country Club in Lakeville, Minnesota on Wednesday, February 23, 1977; and

WHEREAS: blind and sighted participants from Minnesota and Norway will be skiing in this international event; and

WHEREAS: these skiers will make the "Starlight Tour" under sponsorships to raise funds for VINLAND NATIONAL CENTER, the health sports facility for the physically handicapped to be built in Minnesota;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, February 23, 1977 as
