ORDINANCE NO. 69

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the City of Spicer, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Minnesota, to Include Certain Lands not Exceeding Two Hundred Acres.

WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Spicer, a municipal corporation of the State of Minnesota, by the property owner having the sole interest therein, to have certain real property hereinafter described included in the limits of the City of Spicer, and;

WHEREAS, it is proposed to annex by virtue hereof to said City of Spicer, said property all of which property is in Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, and;

WHEREAS, the property to be annexed consists of three parcels described as follows, to-wit:

That part of Lot 2 of the Subdivision of Government Lots 4 and 5 of Section 2, Township 120, Range 34, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the point of intersection of the West line of said Section 2 and the Center line of State Aid Road No. 10, running thence in a southeasterly direction along the said center line a distance of 147.1 feet to a point, thence bearing South $5^{\circ} 38'$ West a distance of 241.6 feet to a point, running thence West a distance of 110 feet to the West line of said Section 2, running thence North on and along the said West line to the point of beginning.

That part of Lot 2 of Subdivision of Government Lots 4 and 5 of Section 2, Township 120, Range 34, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point in the center line of the County Road, which said point is 147.1 feet distant, measured along said center line from its point of intersection with the West line of said Section 2, thence bearing South $5^{\circ} 38'$ West a distance of 241.6 feet to a point, thence East and perpendicular to the said Section line a distance of 70 feet to a point, thence bearing North $8^{\circ} 22'$ East a distance of 202.74 feet to a point in the said center line on the said County Road, thence Northwesterly on and along the said center line to the point of beginning; and, That part of Government Lot 5, Section 2, Township 120 North, Range 34 West, described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the point in the center line of County Road which said point is 232.9 feet measured Southeasterly along the said center line from its point of intersection with the West line of said Section 2; thence bearing South $8^{\circ} 22'$ West a distance of 202.75 feet to a point, which point is the point of beginning of the tract herein conveyed; thence bearing West a distance of 180 feet to a point in the

aforesaid West line of Section 2; thence South on and along the West line a distance of 70.5 feet to a point thereon; thence bearing South 89° East a distance of 180 feet; thence Northerly to the point of beginning.

That part of Lot 2 of Subdivision of Government Lots 4 and 5 of Section 2, Township 120, Range 34, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the intersection of the center line of the County Road as established prior to 1963 and the West line of the said Section 2, which point of intersection is 503.2 feet, bearing South, from the meander corner between Sections 2 and 3 of said township and range, as measured on the West line of the said Section 2, and thence running Southeasterly on and along the said center line South 63° 55' East a distance of 232.9 feet, to a point in the said center line, and which point is the point of beginning of the tract to be herein described; thence bearing South 8° 22' West a distance of 202.75 feet to a point; thence bearing South parallel with the said West line a distance of 70.5 feet to a point; thence bearing South 88° 28' East a distance of 73 feet to a point; thence bearing North 9° 42' East to the said center line of the said County Road as established prior to 1963; running thence Northwesterly on and along the said center line to the point of beginning, subject to easement for highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Spicer hereby determines, ordains, and declares as follows:

I.

That the annexation would be in the best interest of the City of Spicer, Minnesota, and to the best interest of the property affected.

II.

That the property above-described butts on the city limits and is so conditioned as property to be subject to City Government.

III.

That the property is hereby annexed to and included within, the City of Spicer, Minnesota, as effectually as if it has originally been a part hereof.

IV.

That this Ordinance shall be filed and shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the filing of a copy of this Ordinance with the

Minnesota Municipal Commission, Green Lake Town Clerk, Kandiyohi County Auditor,
and the Secretary of the State of Minnesota, from and after its passage and publication.
