

No. 19 on S.E. Corner of Lot 5 of Sec. 11-62-17, and about 200 feet North of the N.W. point of Lot 6 of said Section, containing approximately 0.75 acre.

An unsurveyed Island located in the Southeastern portion of the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 62 North, Range 17 West, 4th P.M., lying East 4° North about 1050 feet from M.C. No. 19 on S.W. Corner of Lot 5 of Sec. 12-62-17, and about 600 feet North from shore line of Lot 6 of said Section, containing approximately 0.50 acre.

You are allowed thirty (30) days from the receipt of this notice, within which to file in said General Land Office, any papers you may wish to submit, tending to show cause, if any there be, why the said two Islands should not be surveyed and disposed of as public land of the United States.
