WHEREAS: the continued forward progress of the State of Minnesota is to a large extent dependent on the good health of its children and youth, the citizens of tomorrow;

and

WHEREAS: total good health -- physical and mental -- can be achieved through good health

habits, learned early; and

WHEREAS: health agencies, health organizations and school health efforts advocate educational programs in support of good dental health habits for young people to prevent dental

disease;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpick, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 6 through 12, 1977 as

CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK

in Minnesota, and wige that all citizens join in the observance.
