Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the National Mothers of Twins Club was organized in Canton, Ohio in 1960; and*

WHEREAS: *the purpose of MOTC is to broaden the understanding of those aspects of child development and rearing which relate to twins; and*

WHEREAS: *this is accomplished through interchange of information among parents, educators, doctors, and others with a direct interest and appropriate experience; and*

WHEREAS: *there are now 185 member clubs in 40 states representing more than 6,800 members; and*

WHEREAS: *there are six Mothers of Twins Clubs in the State of Minnesota; and*

WHEREAS: *the Minneapolis Minnesota Mothers of Twins Club is sponsoring the state's second workshop in St. Paul on April 23, 1977;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 23, 1977 to be

MOTHERS OF TWINS DAY

in Minnesota.
