Proclamation

WHEREAS: Parents Without Partners, Inc. is an international, non-profit, non-sectarian, educational organization devoted to the welfare and interests of single parents and their children; and

WHEREAS: it is the primary endeavor of these conscientious single parents to bring their children to healthy maturity, with the full sense of being loved and accepted as persons, and with the same prospects for normal adulthood as children who mature with their two parents together; and

WHEREAS: through many chapters throughout the United States, Canada and other countries, Parents Without Partners, has helped countless persons, adults and children alike, to benefit from professional and educational services which cooperate closely with these P.W.P. chapters, thereby enabling them to help themselves to a greater understanding and handling of the difficulties involved in this particular state of life; and

WHEREAS: Parents Without Partners was founded March 1957 in the State of New York and this year is celebrating its 20th Anniversary; and

WHEREAS: the Northland Regional Council of Minnesota will sponsor a Conference of Parents Without Partners, Inc. in Bloomington, Minnesota at the Sheraton/Airport Hotel and a Founders' Day Ball at the Radisson South Hotel on March 26, 1977;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 20 through 26, 1977 to be
