Proclamation


- WHEREAS: home economics is the field of knowledge and service primarily concerned with strengthening family life; and
- WHEREAS: home economists are active in business, education, communications, research and legislation, and in health, welfare and ecological programs; and
- WHEREAS: through their professional skills, home economists improve our living standards and the quality of family life; and
- WHEREAS: the American Home Economics Association, an educational and scientific organization founded in 1909, is among the 20 largest professional organizations in the United States with a membership of more than 53,000 men and women; and
- WHEREAS: the national president resides in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: the Minnesota Home Economics Association, one of 52 affiliates of AHEA, has a membership of 2,000; and
- WHEREAS: "Home Economists Influence the Future: Energy" is the area of emphasis for 1976-77, and "Energy: The Human Dimension" is the theme of the Annual Convention of the Minnesota Home Economics Association, which will convene in Minneapolis, March 25 and 26;

HOME ECONOMICS WEEK


in Minnesota, and on behalf of all citizens, wish all participants a most rewarding and enjoyable annual meeting.
