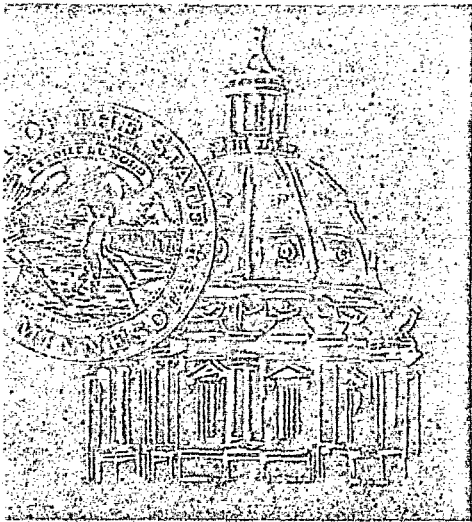

WHEREAS: these professionals need the informed support of our community to continually maintain and improve the quality of social services to individuals and groups;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 1977 to be

and call on each citizen to join the Minnesota Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers in this observance;


FURTHERMORE, I urge each citizen to join and support the social work profession in its efforts to advance the quality of life in our community.
