AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

State of Minnesota  
County of Chicago

10th 23, 1976  
ORDINANCE NO. 03  
An Ordinance extending the corporate limits of the City of Chicago City, Minnesota.  
WHEREAS the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough, and  
WHEREAS the sole owners of the property described below petitioned the City Council of the City of Chicago City, Minnesota on the 7th day of June, 1976 to annex the same to the City of Chicago City, Minn.

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted by the City Council on June 7, 1976 and served upon the Chicago County Board of Commissioners, the Chicago Lakes Township Board and the Minnesota Municipal Commission by mailing a copy of same to each of them on the 22nd day of July, 1976, the said City Council expressed its intention to annex the territory described below to said City, and,  
WHEREAS no objections have been received from any party as to the proposed annexation.

NOW THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Chicago City, Chicago County, Minnesota ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The corporate limits of the City of Chicago City are hereby extended to include the property legally described as follows:

- Lots 1, 2, 3 and 10, 13, 15 except the West 1/2 thereof, Block 42
- Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, South 1/2 Lot 5, South 1/2 of Lot 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, Block 43
- Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 23, 25, 27, 31 and 32, Block 50
- All of Block 53
- Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, Block 59
- All of Chicago City Plat

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance, together with the Affidavit of Publication thereof, with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Chicago County, Minnesota and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

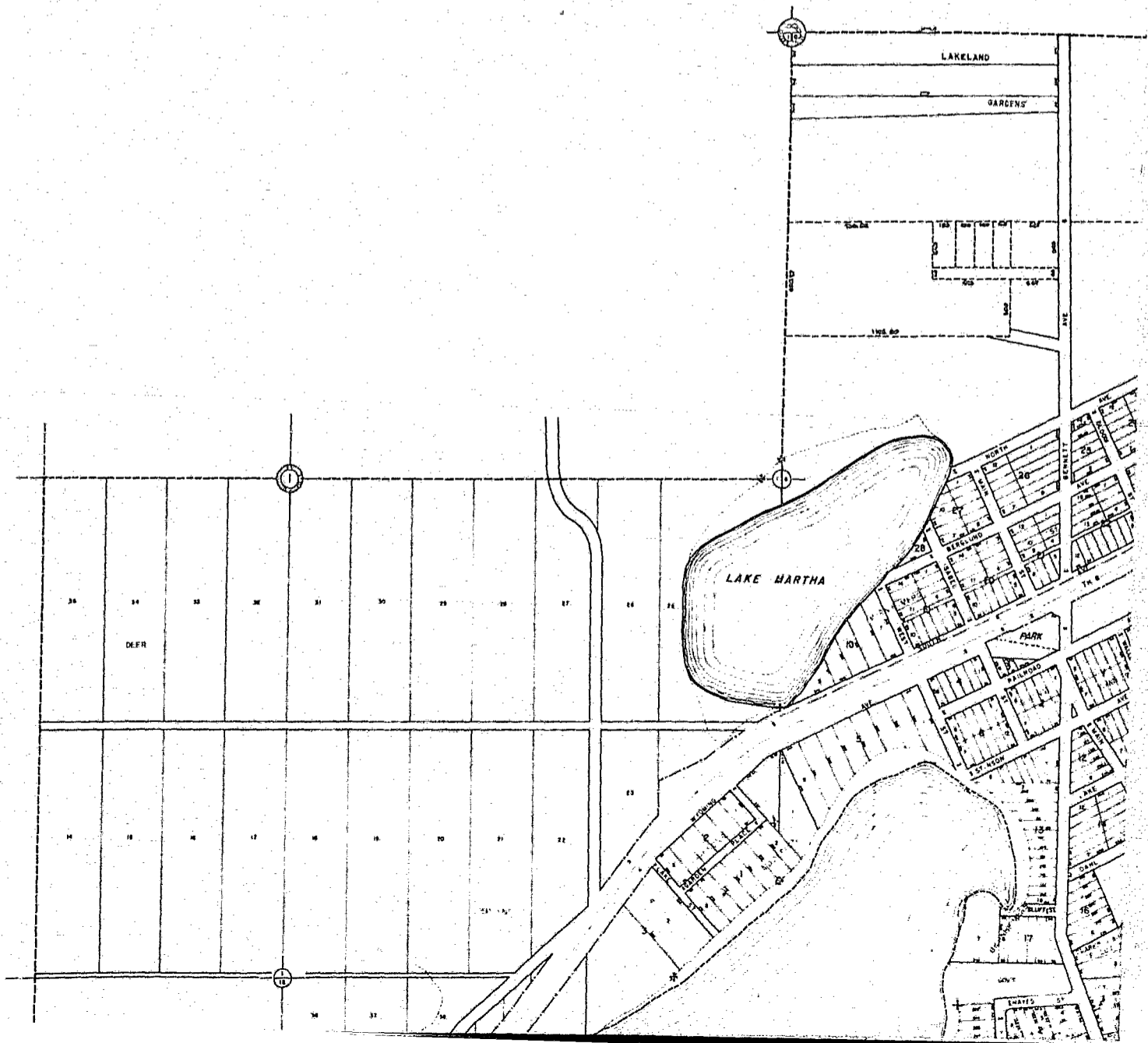
James [Name] being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as the Chicago County Press and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: 1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 200 square inches. 2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. 3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of extracts, plate matter and advertisements. 4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second class matter in its local post office. 5) Said newspaper purports to serve the Village of Lindstrom in the county of Chicago and has its known office of issue in the Village of Lindstrom in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business of the newspaper and business related thereto. 6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. 7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication listed below. 8) Said newspaper has filed with the secretary of state prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the secretary of state and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper. 9) Said newspaper was on May 20, 1965 qualified as a medium of official and legal publication and has continually thereafter met the foregoing conditions.

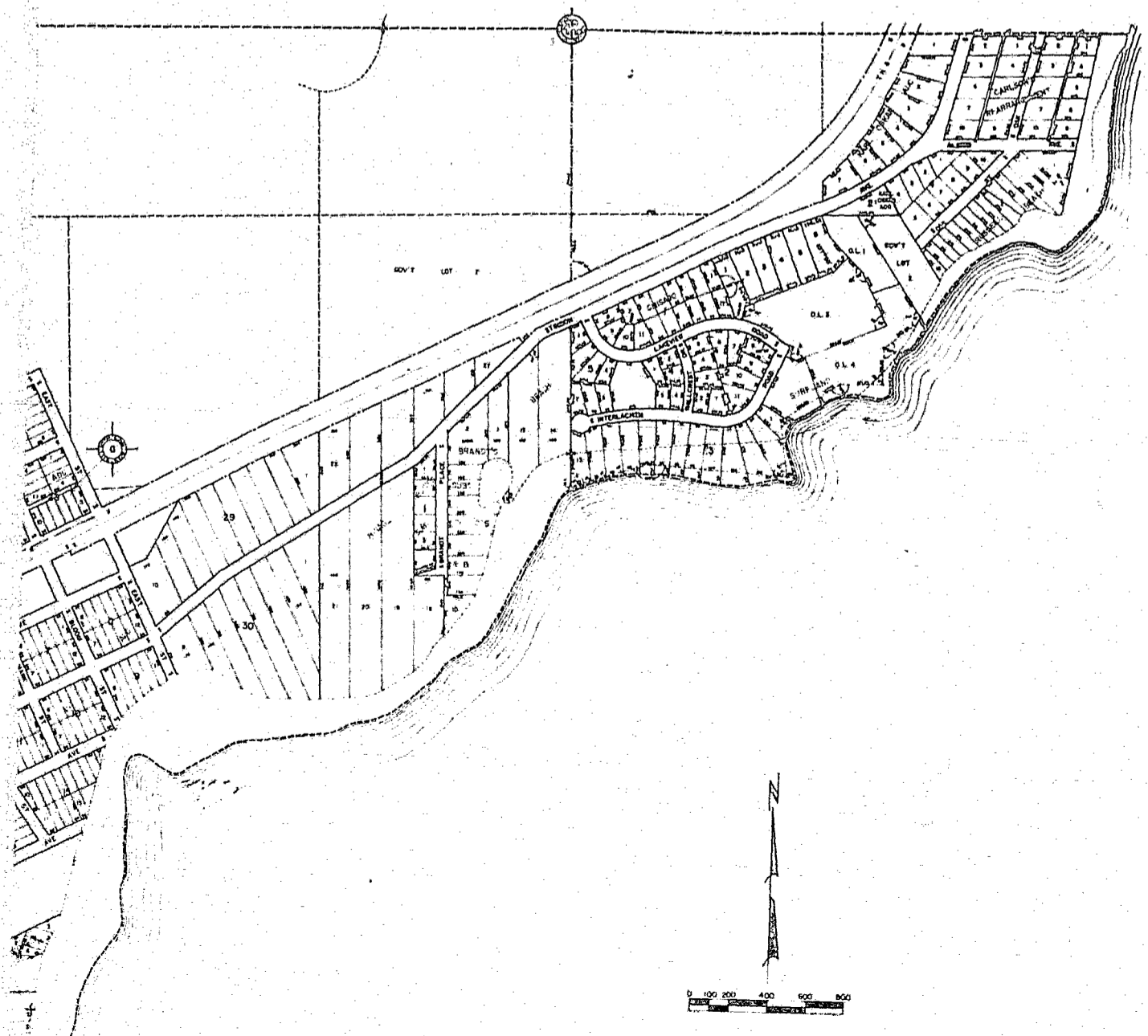
