

ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 242

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
CITY OF SLEEPY EYE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED
PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

The City of Sleepy Eye does Ordain as Follows:

WHEREAS, a certain Petition dated February 2, 1977, requesting annexation of the territory herein described was duly presented to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition is 2.75 acres, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Home Township in which the land is located has waived any objections to said annexation; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the city limits at the eastern boundary thereof;

The City of Sleepy Eye does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interest of the City and of the territory affected, that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban or suburban in character, and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city and does not abut upon the limits of any other city.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Lot One (1) of Lot "N" of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32), Township One Hundred Ten (110), Range Thirty-two (32), containing 1.25 acres.

Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot One (1) of Lot "N" of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32), Township One Hundred Ten (110), Range Thirty-two (32), Brown County, Minnesota, then south 360 feet, then east 181.5 feet, then north 360 feet, then west 181.5 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, Secretary of State, the Home Township Clerk and the County Auditor.

Section 4. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
