thousand Minnesotans and twenty-two million Americans who suffer from some

form of hearing or speech disability; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May as

HEARING AND SPEECH MONTH

in Minnesota, and commend the humanitarian and rehabilitative services, both public and private, available to citizens with hearing and speech disorders.
