



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: *thirty-two years ago marked the end of the tragic Holocaust at the hands of the Nazi oppressors; and*

WHEREAS: *we must honor the commitment by remembering the more than six million Jewish men, women, and children who perished under the Nazi Regime in Europe; and*

WHEREAS: *it is important that the horror and tragedy and the inhumanities suffered by the victims not be forgotten; and*

WHEREAS: *it is our resolve that such a demonstration of man's inhumanity to man shall never again occur; and*

WHEREAS: *on Thursday, April 14, 1977, many Minnesotans will be gathering at the Jewish Community Center of St. Paul to honor the commitment of remembering those who perished;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby mark this remembrance with the hope that the commemoration of this event will strengthen the resistance of people all over the world to prevent and resist the recurrence of such an event anywhere in the world. I call upon all Minnesotans to join with me in this resolve.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Governor's Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this thirteenth day of April in the year one thousand nine hundred seventy-seven and of the State the one hundred nineteenth.
