

An unsurveyed Island located in the central northern portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 63 North, Range 13 West, 4th P.M., lying 2.5 chains south and 1.25 chains west from M.C. on Northeast point of Lot 4 of said Section, and 1.75 chains due West of West point of Lot 3 of Sec. 20-63-13, containing approximately 0.10 acre.


