

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 1977 to be




in Minnesota, and urge the citizens to do all within their considerable power to learn more about the Montessori approach to education and encourage its continued development and growth.
