WHEREAS: ROTC detachments provide both excellent training and experience in leadership and management and create a sense of service to country; and




NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 7, 1977 to be


ROTC DAY
