HEREAS: Norman M. Lorentzsen, president of Burlington Northern Inc., was born on November 29, 1915 in Horace, North Dakota; and

HEREAS: the Lorentzsen family moved to Dilworth soon after where Mr. Lorentzsen was graduated from high school; and

HEREAS: he is a 1941 graduate of Concordia College, Moorhead, with a major in economics, and is now a Regent at that institution of higher learning; and

HEREAS: he also is a graduate of the Harvard Business School's Advanced Management Program; and

HEREAS: after graduation from college, Mr. Lorentzsen enlisted in the Navy and served four years as a pilot; and

HEREAS: Mr. Lorentzsen began his distinguished and illustrious career as a railroad executive at the bottom; and

HEREAS: he first worked as a section laborer and brakeman in Dilworth and, following his discharge from the Navy, he resumed his railroad employment as Dilworth's assistant trainmaster; and

HEREAS: in 1949, Mr. Lorentzsen was promoted to trainmaster at Missoula, Montana, and thereafter advanced to supervisory jobs that increased his working knowledge of how to run a railroad; and

HEREAS: by 1968, Mr. Lorentzsen was Northern Pacific's vice president in charge of operations, retained that position following the Burlington-Northern merger, and was elected executive vice president the next year; and

HEREAS: on July 1, 1973, Mr. Lorentzsen was elected president of the Burlington Northern's Transportation Division, and on January 1, 1977, he was elected president of the company, thus joining an esteemed and select few in the history of the great railroads; and

HEREAS: Mr. Lorentzsen will be honored by the City of Tilworth on Friday, April 22, 1977, an event sponsored by the Dilworth Lions Club and featuring an Italian spaghetti dinner prepared and served by the ladies of St. Elizabeth's Catholic Church;
