WHEREAS: in Queen Isabella are found all the queenly accomplishments sought in the character of a Christian sovereign; and

WHEREAS: the union of Isabella and Ferdinand laid the foundation of modern Spain; and

WHEREAS: Isabella was an energetic reformer, efficient administrator and a patriotic ruler; and

WHEREAS: she deserves praise for the conquest of Granada and for bringing peace to Europe; and

WHEREAS: she exercised great wisdom and valiant courage throughout her reign, changing the course of history for all mankind; and

WHEREAS: it was Queen Isabella who sponsored Christopher Columbus on his daring voyage that led to the discovery of the New World; she is often called the Godmother of America; and

WHEREAS: the Daughters of Isabella have chosen to glorify their order with her name and "to preserve the memory and worth of a brilliant woman;" and

WHEREAS: the 526th birthday anniversary of Isabella, Queen of Castile, will be celebrated on April 22, 1977;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the day of her birth, April 22, to be
