
## State of Minnesota

WHEREAS: 2-2 Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries will hold its Fourteenth Annual Convention on April 30, 1977; and

WHEREAS: mimbers of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries adhere to a strict Code of Ethics, maintaining the highest standards in their contacts with government, curts, law offices, clients, and all persons; and

WHEREAS: the efficiency of the professional services of legal secretaries is of first importance to government, the courts, and to attorneys and their clients; and
