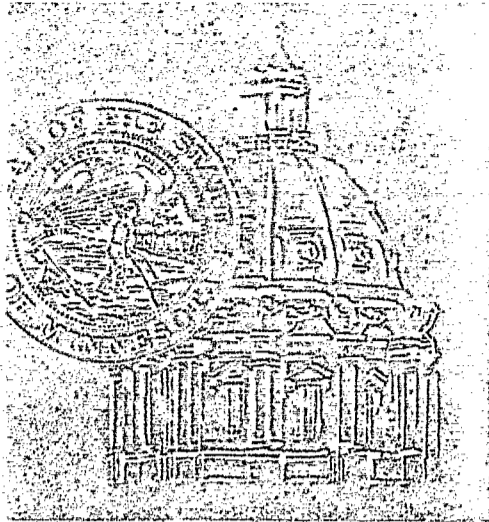


State of Minnesota



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries will hold its Fourteenth Annual Convention on April 30, 1977; and*

WHEREAS: *members of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries adhere to a strict Code of Ethics, maintaining the highest standards in their contacts with government, courts, law offices, clients, and all persons; and*

WHEREAS: *the efficiency of the professional services of legal secretaries is of first importance to government, the courts, and to attorneys and their clients; and*

WHEREAS: *one of the aims and purposes of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries is to further the education of its members and to increase their knowledge of the law; and*

WHEREAS: *it is in the public interest that legal secretaries have the opportunity to observe the government with which they are so closely associated by reason of their profession as legal secretaries;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 30, 1977 as

LEGAL SECRETARIES DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and appreciate the safeguards to our liberty provided by our government of laws and by the orderly process of our courts.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this thirteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-seven and of the State the one hundred nineteenth.
