WHEREAS: this program has produced 21 National Champions and many notable Olympic skiers; and

WHEREAS: every year, the boys and girls who have participated in the Nordic Ski Program are

Selmer's guests at a banquet and are presented awards for their accomplishments; and

WHEREAS: the banquet date this year is Thursday, April 14, 1977;
