WHEREAS: the St. Vasilije of Ostrog Serbian Eastern Orthodox Church of Chisholm, Minnesota, is holding its 30th Annual Serbian Days, July 9 and 10; and

WHEREAS: the St. Vasilije of Ostrog Church is celebrating its 67th Anniversary, and served the spiritual needs of the Serbian community in the State of Minnesota until 1923, when additional churches came into existence; and

WHEREAS: in order to meet the social and cultural needs of the Serbian community, a magnificent social hall was built in 1964; and

WHEREAS: the St. Vasilije of Ostrog Serbian Orthodox Church of Chisholm was rejuvenated by building a new house of worship, a new parish home and a church office, which were consecrated during the Serbian Days celebration, July, 1973; and




NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 9 and 10, 1977 as


