and White Ball in Minneapolis on Saturday, May 7, 1977;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month

in Minnesota, to commemorate the naacp's Legal Defense Fund's role as a leader in the national struggle for civil rights for 38 years.
