WHEREAS: *this year, the Salvation Army of St. Paul is celebrating its 90th Anniversary of service; and*


WHEREAS: *the Salvation Army of St. Paul is the oldest continuous charity in the State of Minnesota; and*

WHEREAS: *the Salvation Army has always honored its pledge: "Hand to man and heart to God;"*


