

## Troclamation

WHEREAS: American Women in Radio and Television, Inc. (A.W.R.T.) is a national professional women's organization, founded in 1951; and

WHEREAS: its 2,500 members in more than 50 chapters in seven geographical areas across the nation are engaged in the broadcast industry and allied fields; and

WHEREAS: this outstanding organization has as its goals:

- + to provide a medium of communication and exchange of ideas,
- + to encourage cooperation within the allied fields of the industry,
- + to promote the advancement of qualified women in broadcasting and allied fields, and
- \*+ to work to improve the quality of radio and television; and

WHEREAS: the dedicated efforts of this organization have also helped to improve the image of women as depicted by radio and television, and increased employment opportunities for women in broadcasting; and

WHEREAS: this distinguished organization has chapter-assisted campus groups for young women in broadcast education known as College Women in Broadcasting; and

WHEREAS: A.W.R.T. was the first broadcasting organization to establish a tax-exempt foundation dedicated to public service and educational projects; and

WHEREAS: for the first time in its 26-year history, A.W.R.T. is holding its annual meeting in Minneapolis;
