
WHEREAS: this day in 1977 will offer all the golfers of America an opportunity to again assist many of these worthy charities and projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Memorial Day, May 30, 1977 as


NATIONAL GOLF DAY


