

An Ordinance.

The Village Council of the Village of Bronson, Kittson County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1, That the following described land, commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (N.E. 1/4, S.E. 1/4) of Section Twenty five (25) Township One hundred sixtione (131) Range Forty-seven (47) thence due west, on the line between the North half and the South half of said Southeast quarter, a distance of Twenty (20) Rods, thence due North a distance of Five (5) Rods, thence due East, parallel to the first described line, a distance of Twenty (20) Rods, thence due South along the Section line to the point of beginning; said tract of land containing One Hundred (100) square Rods, situate upon the incorporated Village of Bronson to be and the same are hereby annexed to said village, and that it become a part of said Village of Bronson as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

Sec. 2, that this Ordinance take effect immediately upon its passage.
