This is to inform you that a special election has been held between the hours of 9 A.M. and 5 P.M. in the Village of Kitzville on October 15th, 1923, for the purpose of voting on the question of whether or not the Village Corporation of the Village of Kitzville shall be dissolved. This is in accordance to a petition, signed by a number of legal voters equal at least to a majority of all legal votes cast at the proceeding village election, that has been presented to the Village Council at their regular meeting of July 3rd, 1923, and pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Village Council of the said Village of Kitzville, October 2nd, 1923.

I hereby certify that the results of said election are as follows:-
There were 50 votes cast, 45 votes for dissolution and 5 votes against dissolution, the election carried for dissolution and the Village of Kitzville was declared dissolved.


