
WHEREAS: this event is made possible through the cooperation of the young men and women of the Future Farmers of America, Chaska Chapter;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 4, 1977 to be


### FARM ANIMALS ON-THE-LAWN DAY
