ORDINANCE NO. 18

An ordinance relating to the annexation of certain property of the Village of Miltona, Minnesota, and extending the corporate limits to encompass said land.

WHEREAS, Harvey V. Wiswell and Dorothy M. Wiswell, his wife, have filed a Petition indicating that they are the sole owners of the hereinafter described property lying and being in the County of Douglas, State of Minnesota; that such land abuts upon the corporate limits of the Village of Miltona; and have Petitioned for the orderly annexation of said property to the Village of Miltona.

WHEREAS, the Petition therefore has been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission as Docket No. A-3046 and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Village of Miltona has examined said Petition, and finds that said property is so conditioned as property to be subject to municipal government; that the present pattern of physical development to the Village of Miltona necessarily provides for expansion and growth into the proposed annexed area; that the natural terrain and general topography makes the area amenable to orderly annexation; that the entire North, East and South boundaries of the said tract proposed to be annexed is contiguous to the Village limits of the Village of Miltona; and that the annexation of said property would be for the best interests of the municipality, and of the territory to be affected and to be annexed.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village council of the Village of Miltona does ordain:

Section 1. That it is for the best interests of the municipality of the Village of Miltona and of the territory hereinafter designated that said territory be annexed to and be made a part of the municipality of the Village of Miltona.

Section II. That the following described land, to-wit:

A part of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township One Hundred Thirty (130) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) West and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: To find the point of beginning commence at the Southwest corner of Block Three (3) of Hintzens First Addition to the Village of Miliona; thence South 87°44' West and on a line parallel to the South line of said Block 3, a distance of 451 feet, thence South and parallel to the West line of said Block 3, a distance of 264 feet to an iron monument, said monument to be the point of beginning, thence from the point of beginning and continuing South on said bearing 100 feet, thence South 87°44' West 120 feet to the West line of said N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence North along said West line 100 feet to the Northwest corner of said N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, thence North 87°44' East 120 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.275 acres more or less according to the survey thereof.

is hereby annexed to and made a part of the municipality of the Village of Miliona, and the corporate limits of the Village of Miliona shall be and are hereby extended to include and encompass the land and territory above described.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the laws in the State of Minnesota, and upon the approval of the State of Minnesota Municipal Commission; and upon filing a copy of the ordinance with the Municipal Commission, the file clerk of Miliona township, the Douglas County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
