

The following is part of the minutes of a meeting of the County Board pertaining to a petition, etc., for the incorporation of the Village of Dovray.

October 2nd, 1922--one o'clock P. M.

The County Board met in special session, pursuant to date set by the Board for the allowing of bills and other business that might be legally considered at this time. All members present. Meeting called to order by Chairman S. Barrows.

The petition of G. Tostengard and others from the Township of Dovray asking for the incorporation of the Village of Dovray, was presented to the Board. On motion made and carried, said petition was approved. The Board then set November 14th, 1922, as the date of election, to be held in the Community Rooms in the bank building in the Village of Dovray, same being within the limits of the territory described in said petition. The County Auditor was instructed to cause notices to be posted, as provided for by the law. On motion made and carried, Christ F. Hager, Edward Olson and A. E. Cohrs, three resident voters within the limits of said proposed incorporation, were appointed as inspectors to conduct said election.
