

Proclamation

WHEREAS: nurse anesthetists who serve in many of our Minnesota hospitals play an important role in providing efficient and modern health care to our citizens; and

WHEREAS: more than fifty percent of all anesthesia today is administered by nurse anesthetists; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Association of Nurse Anesthetists, which has 565 members, provides leadership in continuing education for certified registered nurse anesthetists; and

WHEREAS: there are nine schools of anesthesia in Minnesota with a total enrollment of 120 students; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Association of Nurse Anesthetists is affiliated with the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists which has a membership of more than 16,000; and


WHEREAS: the object of this Association is to facilitate cooperation between the nurse anesthetists and the medical profession, hospitals and other agencies interested in anesthesia;


