WHEREAS: the flying of the flag on a continuous basis is a reminder for our people to keep alive the Spirit of America;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, June 14, 1977 as

FLY THE FLAG DAY


