WHEREAS: the China-Burma-India Veterans Association will hold its Thirtieth Annual Conven-

tion in Minnesota, during the first week of August 1977, at the L'Hotel Sofitel;

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Basha of the CBI is confident that this convention will be one of
