


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, August 6, 1977 to be

SHRINE BOWL DAY


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to support this annual endeavor by attending the Minnesota Shrine All Star Football Game at Metropolitan Stadium.
