WHEREAS: Nurses in the Air Force continue to carry out their mission worldwide, in the air and on the ground, always striving for greater perfection in their field;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 17, 1977 as

in Minnesota, in recognition of the importance of Air Force Nurses to our national defense and our quality of life.


FURTHERMORE, I urge all citizens to extend congratulations to Nurses in the Air Force in the month of their anniversary, and to support them in their worthy endeavors.
