AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE RECONVEYING INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF LYND
PROPERTY ACQUIRED BY A. E. DEWITT, SUCCESSOR PUR-
SUANT TO CH. 44.022

The Common Council for the City of Lynd do hereby enact as follows:

Section 17.101. That the following described property be hereby incorporated
within the City Limits of Lynd:

All that part of Section 27, T. 141 N., R. 25W of the 5th Principal Meridian
in Lyon County, Minnesota described as follows: Commencing at the in-
tersection of the northeasterly line of Fourth Street with the northwesterly
line of Rice Street in the City of Lynd; thence northeasterly along the
northwesterly line of Rice Street 214.5 feet; thence northwesterly at right
angles 214.5; thence northwesterly at right angles 214.5 feet; thence northerly
and parallel with the West line of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 27
a distance of 200 feet to the true point of beginning; thence northerly along
the prolongation of the last described line 405 feet; thence easterly at right
angles 205 feet; thence southerly at right angles 405 feet; thence westerly
205 feet to the true point of beginning and containing 2.11 acres more or
less. Excepting therefrom encumbrances of record.

All that part of Section 27, T. 141 N., Range 28 West of the 5th Principal
Meridian in Lyon County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing
at the intersection of the northeasterly line of Fourth Street with the
northwesterly line of Rice Street in the City of Lynd; thence northeasterly
along the northwesterly line of Rice Street 214.5 feet; thence northwesterly
at right angles 214.5 feet to the true point of beginning; thence northerly
and parallel with the West line of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section
27 a distance of 205 feet; thence easterly at right angles 205 feet; thence
northerly and parallel with the west line of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of
said Section 27 a distance of 315 feet; thence easterly at right angles 1/2
feet; thence southerly and parallel with the West line of the NE 1/4 of the
SW 1/4 of said Section 27 a distance of 415 feet; thence southwesterly and
parallel with Rice Street 400 feet to the true point of beginning and con-
taining 2.11 acres more or less. Excepting therefrom encumbrances of record.

Section 17.102. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and
publication.

Passed and adopted by the Village Council on the 14th day of June, 1977.
