WHEREAS: General Patrick J. Halloran was born in Chatfield, Minnesota in 1928, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Leo Halloran; and

WHEREAS: He is a graduate of Chatfield High School, the Air War College at Maxwell Air Force Base, and Troy (Alabama) State University; and

WHEREAS: General Halloran is a command pilot with 6700 flying hours and was one of the first pilots to fly the triple-sonic SR 71 reconnaissance aircraft; and

WHEREAS: he joined the Air Force in 1949. His first assignment was with the Strategic Air Command's 31st Fighter Wing, followed by a tour in Korea where he flew 100 combat missions in the F84 and earned his first Distinguished Flying Cross; and

WHEREAS: he then was assigned to the highly classified U-2 program with the 4028th Strategic Reconnaissance Squadron at Laughlin AFB in 1957 and earned his second DFC; in 1961 he became Chief of the U-2 Wing Standardization Division and subsequently Squadron Deputy Commander, accumulating more than 1600 flying hours; and

WHEREAS: on July 1, 1976, Patrick J. Halloran was promoted to Chief of Staff, 15th Air Force Strategic Air Command at March AFB, with the responsibility for SAC operations in the Western United States and Alaska; and

WHEREAS: on April 1, 1977, he was promoted to the rank of Brigadier General for the SAC with headquarters at Offutt AFB, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS: General Halloran is the first native born Chatfield resident in the community's 124 year history to achieve the rank of general; and

WHEREAS: he will be Honorary Grand Marshal in Chatfield's 10th Annual Western Days Parade and Celebration on Saturday, August 13, 1977;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim that day, August 13 to be
