
State of Minnesota



Troclamation.

WHEREAS: the Twin City Society of X-ray Technicians met on March 8, 1938 to accept the Bylaws and Constitution for the American Society of Radiologic Technologists. The purpose of this meeting was to establish all affiliated societies of radiologic technologists under a uniform foundation; and

WHEREAS: a committee of registered radiologic technologists met to formulate definite plans regarding organization of the Minnesota Society on September 8, 1938. The committee then met for organization in November 1938 at the home of Alfred Greene, R.T. (ARRT) to make plans for the first meeting; and

WHEREAS: the new Minnesota Society of Radiologic Technologists, formerly the Minnesota Society of X-ray Technicians embraced the Twin City Society of X-ray Technicians and the Arrowhead Society with 47 members on December 10, 1938; and

WHEREAS: on December 10, 1938, the Minnesota Society of Radiologic Technologists, formally organized to become recognized as an affiliate society of the American Society of Radiologic Technologists; and

WHEREAS: the 2,300 Registered Radiologic Technologists of the State of Minnesota have recognized the need for continued professional growth and education in the exchange of technical information to better the patient care; and

WHEREAS: the dedication of these people has stood in testimony of their concern for improved patient care through radiation protection, continuing education and need for exchange of information for thirty-five years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 25 through October 1, 1977 to be

in Minnesota, in honor of the dedicated technologists who live and work in our state.
