merger of the Hennepin County Medical Center and the Metropolitan Medical Center; and

WHEREAS: this management and planning effort is the most significant merger of a public hospital

and a private hospital in the nation; and

WHEREAS: William Kreykes is leaving Minnesota to conquer new challenges as Executive Director of

Vanderbilt University Hospitals and Clinics in Nashville, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS: he is being honored at a luncheon on August 11, 1977;
