
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, August 28, 1977 to be the

17th ANNUAL CROATIAN DAY


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to mark this observance, and pay tribute to the outstanding contributions made by the people of Croatian descent to Minnesota.
