WHEREAS: hundreds of Minnesota's waterfowl lakes are world famous; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Waterfowl Association, chartered in 1967, was instrumental in securing state legislation for waterfowl management lakes in Minnesota and the state Waterfowl Stamp; and

WHEREAS: members are actively engaged in restoring and managing shallow lakes, wildlife management areas, and private lands for waterfowl habitat development; and

WHEREAS: the Annual Hunter's Parties, sponsored by the Minnesota Waterfowl Association, will be held on September 10 and September 15; and

WHEREAS: two parties are being planned because of growing interest and increasing attendance by sportsmen from all areas of the state; and




NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 12, 1977 to be


in Minnesota.
