
WHEREAS: a state-wide campaign to inform the public about this special problem has been plan^d for the month of October;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October as

LEARNING DISABILITIES MONTH


